Thank you Lynley for stepping up to this position.

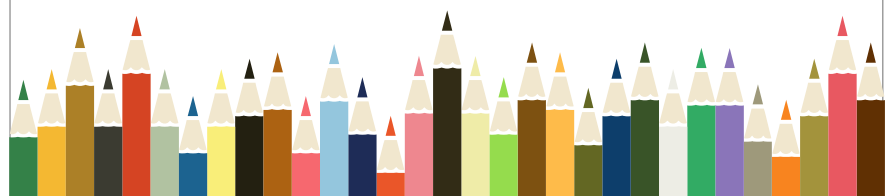

Hot Cross buns:

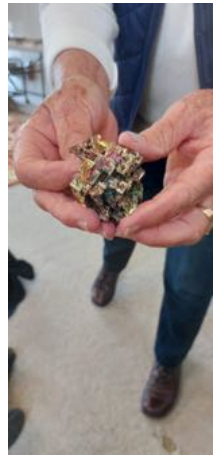
Yesterday room 2 made hot cross buns.
