### **Duffy theatre:** Wednesday 8th May 2024 @ 11:00am.

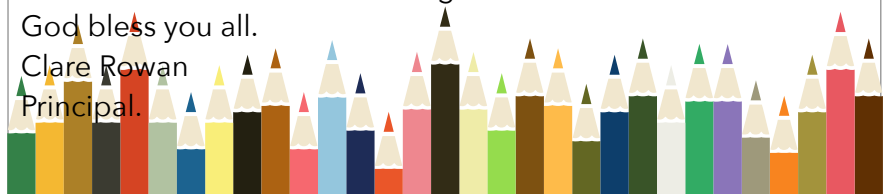
We will be travelling by bus to Hawera Primary School for the performance.

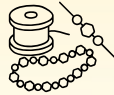
