Please ring the office and let us know if you can assist with swimming supervision.

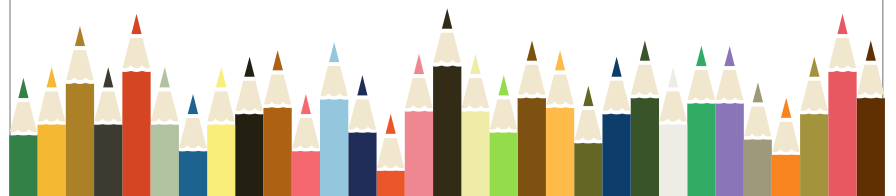
Prefects:

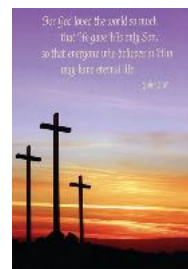
