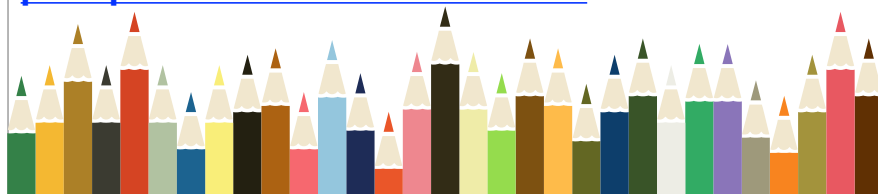
Basketball:
